What is TxDOT TA Program?

- TxDOT's Public Transportation Division administers federal funding programs, including FHWA and FTA funds for non-motorized and transit projects.
- The Transportation Alternative Set-aside (TA) funds are for locally sponsored bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure and planning projects in communities across the state.
- Program focus areas:
 - Reflects collaboration and community consensus.
 - Supports local needs.
 - Promotes safety, mobility, and connectivity.

Bus Stop Improvement Program Grant Application

- Advance Support for: CPG0291 Bus Stop Construction and CPG0288 Bus Stop Amenities
- Total project cost: \$6,926,190.00
- Local match commitment (20%): \$1,385,238.00
- Project Period: Three years (FY27-FY29)
- Project Scope: Construct **87 ADA-compliant priority transit stops**
 - Equip 17 transit stops with amenities.
 - Recommendations from CapMetro's ADA Transition Plan.
 - Improve overall rider experience by prioritizing safety and accessibility for all.
 - Benefits individuals with mobility needs, including those with sensory and cognitive disabilities.

- Submit Detailed Application by June 20, 2025, deadline
 - TxDOT Detailed Application review complete: August 22, 2025
 - Commission Award: October 2025
