EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Gallagher Benefits Services has obtained quotes for stop loss insurance from United Healthcare, Voya Employee Benefits and High Mark (HM) Insurance Group. The price quote from Voya for \$225,000 individual stop loss insurance is \$310,887 less than the current stop loss insurance with Highmark Insurance Group and the lowest of the quotes received. The Stop Loss coverage provided by Voya Employee Benefits is underwritten by ReliaStar Life Insurance Company, a member of the Voya family of companies. Both Voya Financial and ReliaStar Life Insurance Company have an AM Best rating of A (Excellent). Voya Employee Benefits is an industry leader and one of the nation's largest direct writers of excess risk (stop loss) insurance for more than 40 years. Voya Employee Benefits, a division of ReliaStar Life Insurance Company, also offers group life, voluntary and disability income insurance products through employers.
