What is CPRG?

City of Austin (COA) awarded ~\$47.9M grant from Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in 2024

Over \$20B of construction will disrupt commutes throughout the region

Prepare for upcoming disruption and develop alternative commute options to reduce Green House Gas (GHG) emissions

COA is the lead agency with CapMetro and other agencies as key implementers, such as:

- CARTS
- CAPCOG
- Movability
- TxDOT
- CAMPO



CPRG Implementation

Grant duration is 5 years (2025-2030)

Implementation (2025-2030) is broken into 3 targeted measures

1. Improving Regional Transit Service
 - Improve or Maintain CapMetro service – CapMetro lead
2. Investing in Mobility Infrastructure
 - Mobility Hubs – CapMetro support
 - Bicycle Investments – CapMetro support
 - Parking Counters – CapMetro support
3. Transit Options & Outreach
 - Transportation Wallet – CapMetro support



Financial Ask

Grant allocates \$10M towards CapMetro service from 2025-2030

ILA provides up to \$10M of reimbursement for CapMetro services

COA approved ILA at 4/24 council meeting

Seeking Board approval to finalize and execute CPRG ILA with COA to reimburse CapMetro up to \$10M

Next Steps

Planning on-going through 2025 – Implementation anticipated to begin in 2026

Implementation targeting investments that are temporary or will last beyond 2030

Temporary Adjustments

- Temporary construction detours
- Temporary passes to encourage ridership

Long-term Investments

- Amenities at or around Mobility Hubs
- Bikeshare Infrastructure
- Security Cameras capturing Parking Counts
